My Profile



- Remove commercial confidentiality clauses from government contracts unless there is a proven need



MY PRIORITIES

Nationally

Grow the economy - Incentives need to be put in place to encourage investors to locate and start up businesses to the Isle of Man as well as to encourage investments locally. Local employment could be helped by reintroducing the NI holiday for new employees. It is our generation's responsibility to secure a long-term future for our children and for generations to come.

Balance the books - Communication of the Island's financial situation is required in order for everyone to understand what needs to be done openly and transparently.

Pensions - The current final salary Public Sector Pension Scheme should be closed to new starters and a viable option investigated which protects existing members

Smarter Working - A change to the legal structure of Government should be evaluated to inform whether the public sector can work more effectively and efficiently.

Taxation - Develop a National Tax Strategy that considers the long-term needs of the Island instead of continuously increasing stealth-like indirect taxation which detrimentally impacts on ordinary working people.

Education - I believe that everyone is entitled to an excellent education. Having gone to University as a single parent, together with my four children, I am acutely aware of the value education has on enabling to people to make the best of themselves.

Locally

Sewerage - There is an urgent need to agree and implement a solution to our sewerage problem in Peel that is sensitive to both local residents and local businesses. This problem existed when I was a child paddling in the sea, it existed when my own children headed down to the beach and now I am expecting a grand-child. Thirty-five years is time enough!

Regeneration - Peel is beautiful and securing regeneration funds to build on Peel's existing charm will encourage tourism and support the local economy.

Grow local business - The provision of small units will assist start-up businesses in Peel which will hopefully grow and employ people locally.

The Harbour - Peel harbour is the most active fishing port in the Isle of Man and is regularly used by hundreds of boat owners but the silt problem, which was raised by harbour users before construction of the marina but not addressed, is an ongoing problem. An acceptable and practical solution needs to be found.

The Environment - Peel needs to be kept clean and tidy and free from dog fouling.
