I am writing to let you know that I have decided to stand in the forthcoming election for Onchan, and wish to let you know my reasons.

My name is June Kelly I am married to Dave and have two grown up daughters. I am very proud to be Manx born and for the past 30 years we have lived in Birch Hill, Onchan.

As a life long member of The Salvation Army and the chair of Onchan Live at Home Scheme and treasurer/secretary of the Onchan Endowment Committee, I am aware of the practical and pastoral needs within the community.



I have been a Commissioner in Onchan for over four years. During that time I was the lead member for housing and open spaces. In 2009–2010 I was given the role of vice chair and was elected in May 2011 as Chairperson for this year. I can assure you that my commitment to be a voice of the people of Onchan continues whether I am elected to the Keys or not.

Since obtaining my degree as a Specialist Practitioner in Public Health seven years ago I have worked as a Health Visitor. This experience has given me an insight to the daily difficulties and needs of our families. I have become aware that real change to people's lives can be made by vigorous campaigning from within Central Government.

I believe that I have the qualities necessary to prioritise the needs of the local population, and to encourage the House of Keys to make provision for policies that will improve the lot of the vast majority of residents whilst still appreciating the need to look after the Island's international business services and standing.

Because of recent international pressure I believe the Keys has focused too much on Revenue replacement and have not targeted overall expenditure. They have relied on tinkering with pre-budgetted spending which affects every individual. Greater emphasis should be placed on looking at unnecessary expenditure schemes.
