HEALTH

 - An open Tynwald ballot for Chief Minister

- Abolish the supplement paid to Tynwald members for memberships of departments and statutory boards
- Appoint an independent Auditor General
- Remove commercial confidentiality clauses from government contracts unless there is a proven need



Maire will not be a politician who will only be seen every five years as we hold monthly meetings and all of our MHKs attend to give their reports and answer any questions.


