

### INFORMATION FOR VOTERS

**Elections for the Isle of Man Government will take place on the 29th September 2011**

24 MHKs (Members of the House of Keys) will be elected for the whole Island.

I am standing for Douglas East, it has 2 seats

From the 24 elected members a Chief Minister is elected and he/she elects a Council of Ministers ( 9 Ministers )

The remaining MHKS can take part in the Government Departments.

Therefore your MHK has a very important influence in Government to represent your interests, concerns or problems.

In order to vote in the Elections you need to be resident on the Island for 1 year

A voter registration form is sent to every property on the Island

You must fill this in and return it to the Registration Office

Fill in your family name, first name, date of birth and sign

All voters with the same Family name can fill in on the same sheet

The Form requires only 1 signature per Family name

If there is someone with a different 'Surname' in the property they must fill in a separate form
