Juneau Fast Break Basketball Camp 2016

PURPOSE:

The Juneau Fast Break Basketball Camp will provide fundamental basketball instruction appropriate for all ages and ability. Our aim is to help campers improve throughout the week, with an emphasis on individual skill development, team play, and execution of basic fundamentals. Campers will learn offensive and defensive skills while gaining valuable opportunities to set and work towards goals, improve physical fitness, and build self-confidence... all through the fun and excitement of the game of basketball.

ELIGIBILITY:

All boys and girls entering grades 2 -12 next school year are eligible to participate. Applicants must have had a physical within the past year. Campers will be divided by age and ability. Camps 1 and 2 will have three levels: Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced. A preference should be marked on the registration form. Adjustments to levels can be made throughout the week to maximize the experience of the camper. Teams bringing seven or more players to Camp 2 will be allowed to compete as a team and pay a special tuition rate of \$170 per member.

SCHEDULE:

Camp 1 – for those entering grades 2 – 8 next year
Orientation will be Sunday, June 12th, from 4pm – 5pm at the Juneau-Douglas High School main gym. Camp will run from June 13 – 17, 9am to 1pm each day. All campers will begin at the JDHS gym each day. Coaches will escort some players to Harborview and/or Marie Drake for instruction, as necessary. All Campers will be picked up from the JDHS main gym at the end of each day.

Camp 2 – for those entering grades 8 – 12 next year
Orientation will be Sunday, June 19th, from 4pm – 5pm at the Juneau-Douglas High School main gym. Camp will run from June 20 – 25, 9am – 5pm. The All-Star games and award ceremony will be held on Saturday, June 25, from 9am – 12pm. All campers should attend All-Star Saturday.

REGISTRATION:

Tuition for Camp 1 is \$100.00 per camper. Tuition for Camp 2 is \$200.00 per camper. Please make checks payable to “Juneau Fast Break Basketball Camp”. Each camp is limited in space and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. You may register by mailing the application and payment to the address on the registration form or you may register in person at orientation. A parent or guardian signature is required on the form.

Families with more than one child attending the camp will receive a one-time \$30.00 discount. Eighth graders attending both Camp 1 and Camp 2 will pay \$260.00.

LOCATION:

All instruction will occur indoors at one or more of the following locations: Harborview gym, Marie Drake gym, or JDHS main gym.

COACHING:

Instructors at the Juneau Fast Break Basketball Camp will include current and former high school, college, and professional players/coaches.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Campers should bring towels, personal hygiene items, basketball shoes, athletic socks, gym shorts, and T-shirts. The Juneau Fast Break Basketball Camp does not provide meals/snacks, but there will be breaks when campers are allowed to eat. Healthy snacks and plastic water bottles (no glass) with closable/sealable lids are encouraged. Campers are advised to leave all valuables at home, as the camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

DISCIPLINE:

Any serious violations of rules and regulations, such as willful damage to school property, being in possession or under the influence of drugs/alcohol, or any other behavior deemed detrimental to the group will result in the camper's immediate dismissal from camp. There will be no refunds upon dismissal or voluntary withdrawal from camp.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE:

Campers are responsible for their own medical insurance coverage. Camp staff will be accessible at all times to handle basic training needs (ice, taping, etc.). Bartlett Regional Hospital is located nearby. In order to minimize common injuries, each participant should report to camp in top physical condition. Efforts will be made to protect the participant's health and safety.
