

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The design proposes targeted enhancements on Main St, The Square, Lineside Rd, Dungannon Rd, Stewartstown Rd, Barrack St, Barrack Sq, Station Rd and Washingbay Rd. The streetscape will be visually lifted with the introduction of new high quality natural stone paving with granite kerbing, street furniture, signage, street lighting, festive lighting boxes and specimen tree planting where appropriate. A new bus lay-by, loading bay and disabled parking spaces shall also be provided.

The overall extent of the scheme is yet to be finalised, and will rely on a number of factors including budget constraints and obtaining consent from statutory authorities and third party landowners.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To create a safe, high quality pedestrian friendly environment,
- be accessible to pedestrians and vehicles,
- have free flowing traffic and retain most on-street parking.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The proposals presented are early concept designs to aid the consultation process and economic appraisal of the scheme. The public response to the proposals will assist the design team in developing a suitable solution which meet the needs and aspirations of the town.

PAVING

The streetscape will be visually enhanced with the introduction of high quality stone paving and granite kerbing. Tactile paving shall provide additional pedestrian crossing as appropriate locations.

LIGHTING

Street lighting will consist of traditional lantern style in the centre of the town and modern lanterns to the main approach roads. LED white lights will be used to provide improved lighting quality. Provision will also be made for festive lighting boxes throughout the scheme.



STREET FURNITURE

Proposed street furniture has been selected to reflect the industrial heritage of the town.



LANDSCAPING

Semi-mature trees to be provide at selected locations.



PUBLIC ART FEATURE

As part of the public realm scheme the Council wish to develop a unique public art feature for the whole community to enjoy.
