Dear Marshall Noel,

I wanted to follow up with you from our meeting today at my office regarding Deputy Marshall Charlie Keyes. It has come to my attention that Deputy Marshall Keyes was not honest in reporting his time coming on duty as well as going off duty as a Deputy Marshall for West Harrison. As a result of these actions, the City of West Harrison paid him for working when he was not. From our conversation today, it is my understanding that these events took place in November of 2018.

The Indiana Rules of Professional Responsibility and the US Supreme Court cases of *Brady v. Maryland* and *Giglio v. US* require me to disclose any information about character for untruthfulness of my witnesses. I must provide disclosure of these allegations against Deputy Marshal Keyes to any defendant or defense attorney who has a case where Deputy Marshall Keyes is a witness or the affiant.

As a result of his actions and the fact that it bears directly on Deputy Marshall Keyes' ability to be truthful, myself and my office will NOT call him as a witness nor accept charges based on his testimony.
